You receive this letter because you and/or your child have registered as a member of football club s.v. Die Haghe. We would like to welcome you to our club!

In this letter we give you some important information about your membership.

Contact

If you have given us your email address, you will receive a message every week with a link to our club magazine, which contains information about matches and training and other important announcements. The club magazine is also published on our website www.svdiehaghe.nl, which also contains the most up-to-date information such as cancellation of matches or training.

On the website you can also find useful addresses. The most important are info@svdiehaghe.nl (secretary) for general matters, jc@svdiehaghe.nl ('jeugdcommissie') for the youth section and dc@svdiehaghe.nl ('damescommissie') for the women's section.

Outfit

The official outfit for matches can be obtained from Free Kick Sport, Weimarstraat 341, phone 070-3636323. Go to www.free-kick.nl/sport/ to visit their web shop.

Membership fee

When you enrolled, you agreed to pay the membership fee through automatic withdrawals from your bank account. Payment will take place in four instalments, once every three months. Payment of the membership fee entitles you to take part in training and matches and to use the democratic rights you have according to the club constitution ('statuten').

Payment for a complete season (July through June) is mandatory. Members who at some point decide to stop playing football must continue to pay their membership fee for the rest of the season. The only exception to this rule are E and F junior members, who only have to pay for three months if they decide to cancel their membership within this period.

Children under 18 who have an 'ooievaarspas' from Den Haag City Council can be eligible for exemption from membership fees. Adults with this 'ooievaarspas' pay half the usual fee.

Please note that your membership and the automatic payment of the membership fee will be renewed automatically at the end of each season. If you wish to end your membership for the next season, you must give notice before 1st June. You can terminate your membership by sending an e-mail to the secretary at info@svdiehaghe.nl

Volunteers

Football club s.v. Die Haghe is in Dutch called a 'vereniging'. Literally this means 'union', which implies that members have 'united' to run a club together. This means that we do not only expect members and parents of youth members to financially contribute to the club, but that they are also required to make an active contribution.


All members and parents of youth members are therefore obliged to take part in the 'bardienst' a few times per season. This is mandatory! You can find further details in the club magazine and on the website.
